## Sector Highlights

Nursing Home assessment rates been steadily rising since 2015. High claim costs for since 2015 and, especially, in 2018 will continue to put an upward pressure on rates.

Time loss injury frequency has also been increasing since 2015. In addition, the time people are missing from work, as a result of a work-related injury, continues to be a concern, as reflected in the increasing number of full time employees that miss a full year of work during any one year.
